

Infection control measures taken before Ravema Expo

The following adjustments have been made, in connection with Ravema Expo, due to the Swedish Public Health Agency's regulations and general advice on special restrictions to prevent the spread of covid-19.

- All staff working at Ravema Expo (applies to both Ravema's own staff and co-exhibitors) must be fully vaccinated and present a valid covid passport / proof.
- All visitors, including co-exhibitors, at Ravema Expo must be fully vaccinated and present a valid covid passport / proof.
- All visitors need to show a valid covid passport / proof in connection with the entrance to Ravema Expo to participate in the fair.
- In connection with the presentation of a covid passport / proof, valid identification is required.
- Information on infection control measures taken in connection with the fair must be available to read at the entrance (this document).
- Hand alcohol must be available throughout the exhibition area.
- Signs to remind people to keep their distance must be placed in the entrance but also in most places in the exhibition area.
- There must be designated corridors / markings to clearly show how to move in the exhibition area. This is important to avoid crowds.

Hand alcohol and gloves must be available in connection with the Christmas lunch served at Ravema Expo.
